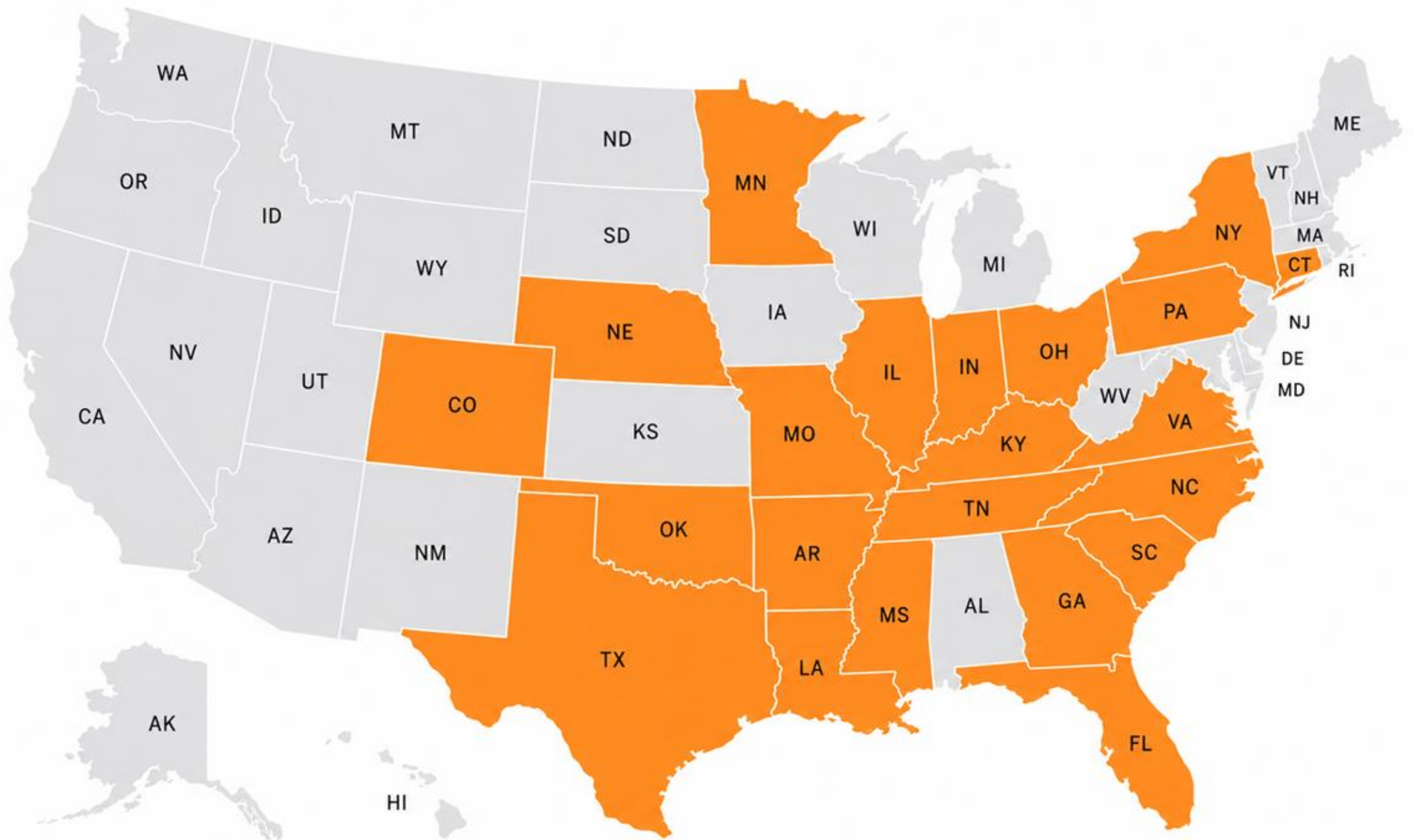

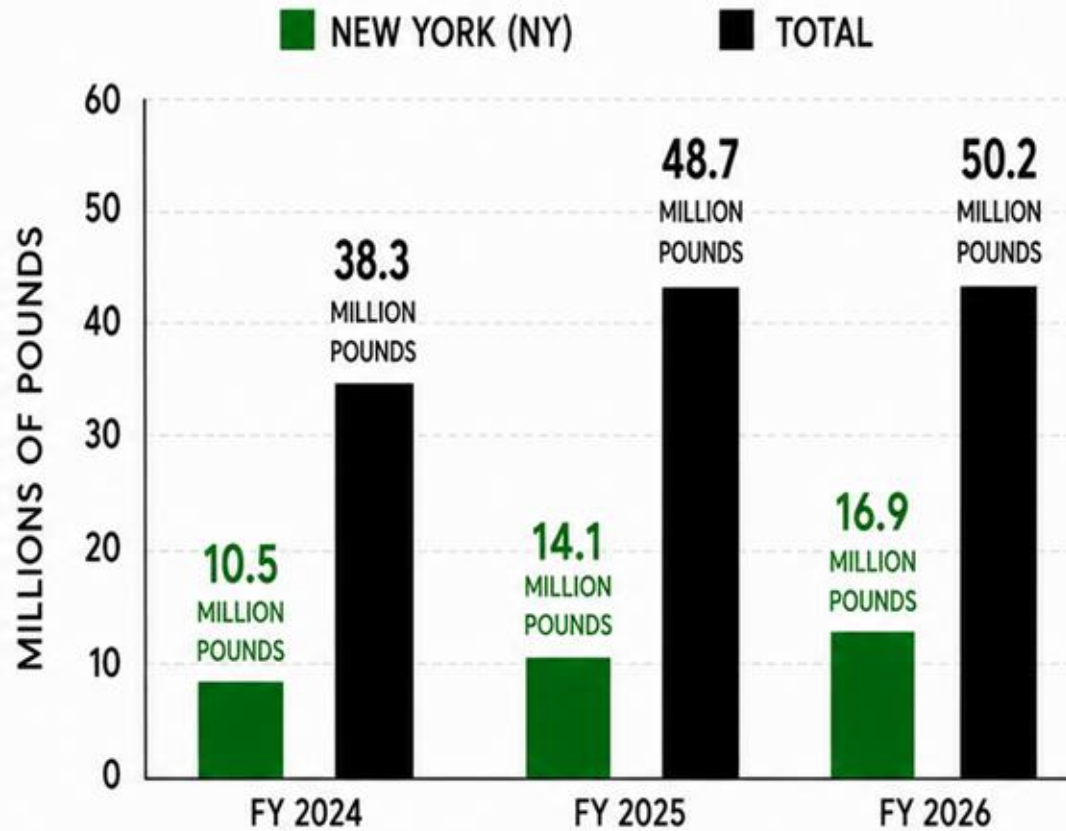




POUNDS ACCEPTED

FISCAL YEARS 2024–2026



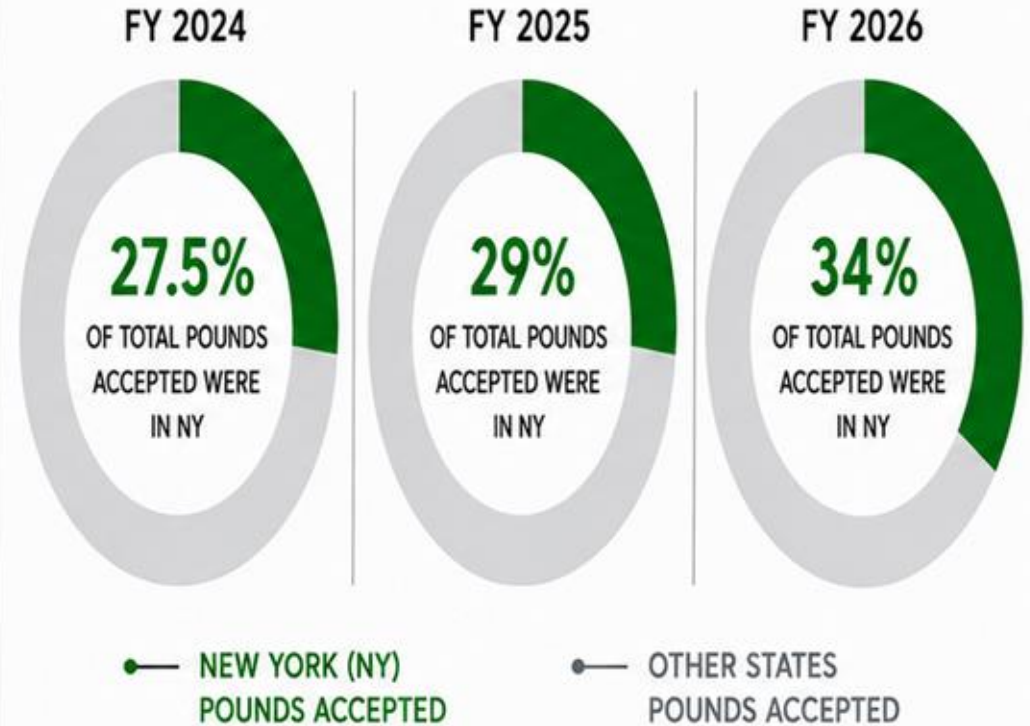
Across the last 3 fiscal years, a total of **41.5 million pounds** were accepted in New York, which represents an average of **30.9%** of the pounds accepted total per year.

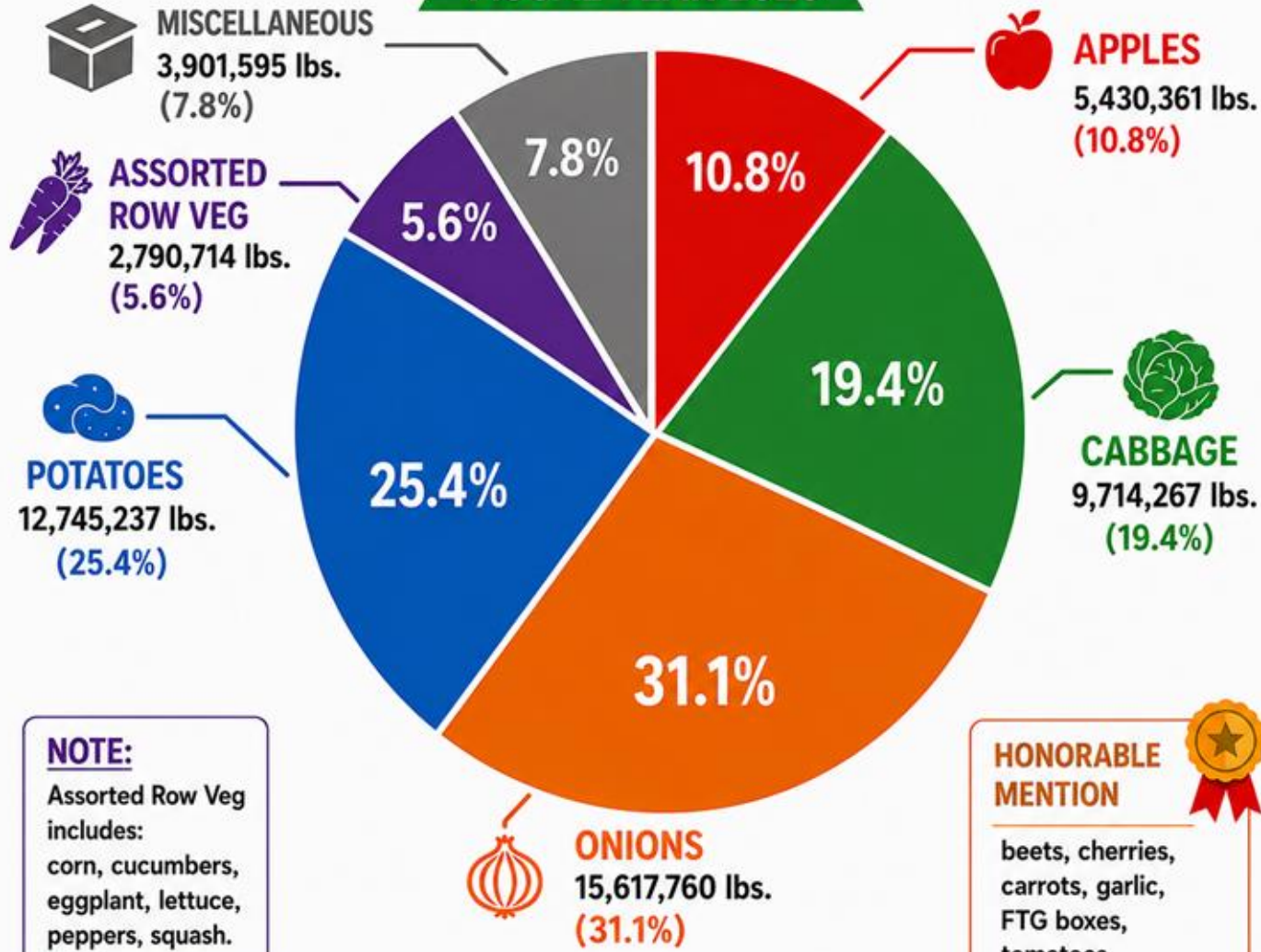

FISCAL YEAR 2026

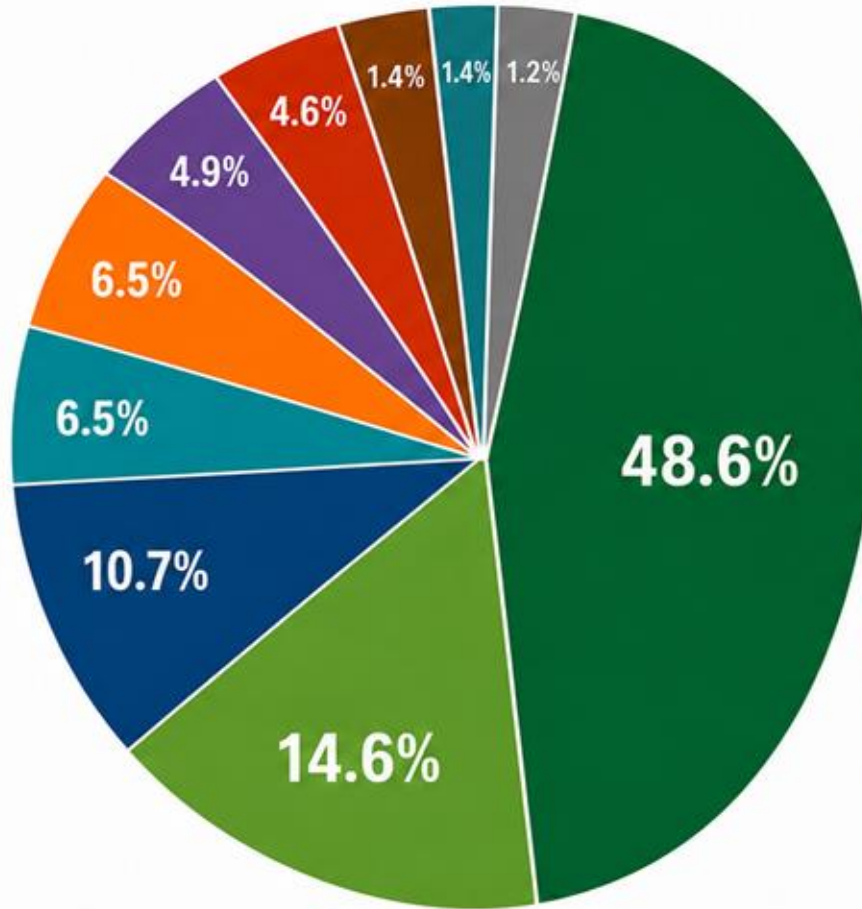
